




National Fish Passage Program

BIL 2022-2025


- \$143 million invested across 122 projects in 40 states, plus Puerto Rico
- Projects leveraged \$192 million
- When complete, these projects would remove 346 barriers opening 12,272 miles and 924,622 acres of river and floodplain habitats

NFPP BIL Funded Dam Removals






Other Barrier




Up Front Work is Critical
